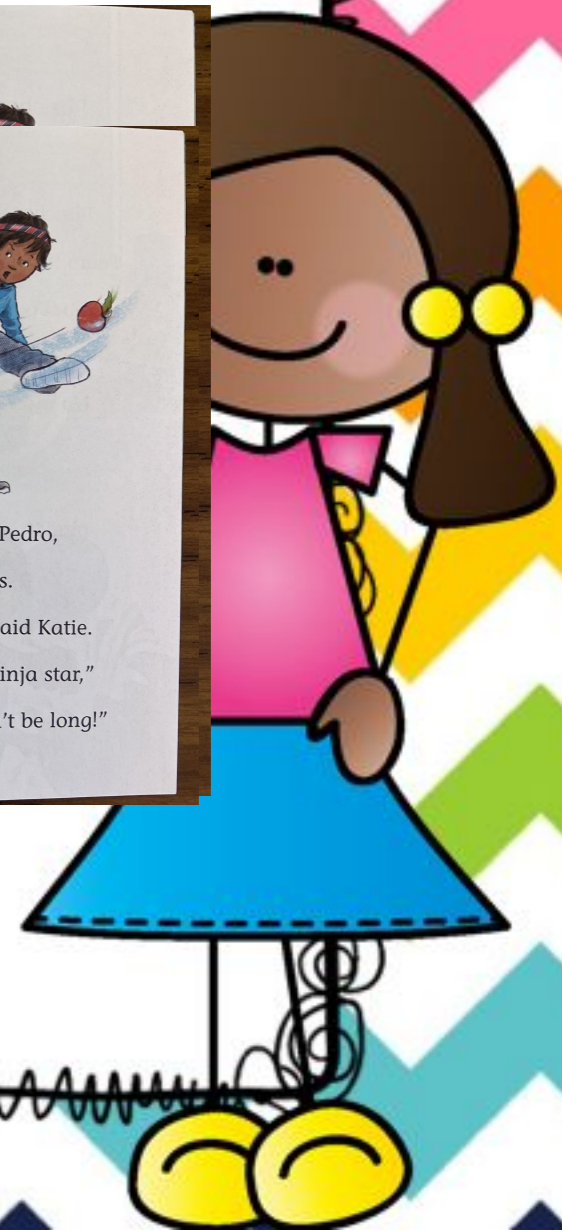
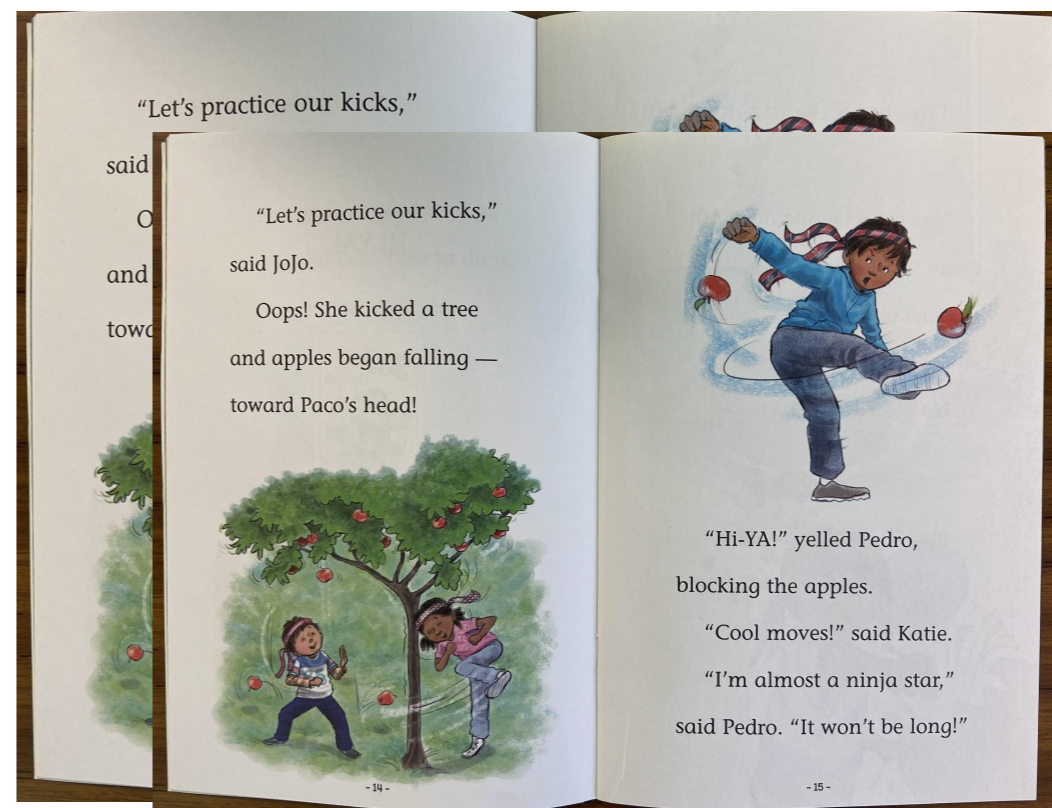

Reading Law

- The goal is for students to be reading on grade level before they leave 3rd grade.
- iReady testing will occur 3 times a year for reading and math. After each diagnostic is administered families will be notified if their first grader did not meet the reading cut score. We will meet to put a reading plan in place.
- This plan is called an IRIP (Individualized Reading Intervention Plan)
- Students on an IRIP will receive targeted instruction in small groups or 1 to 1 based on their needs.
 - There is an “at home” component.

• Sidenote: First graders will also take a math iReady diagnostic



Literacy Support

Carolyn Kevelin -Instructional Specialist

- Reading Recovery -4 students each round
 - 1 on 1 intensive reading intervention
 - 12-20 weeks-two rounds a school year
 - 30 minute lessons 5 days a week
 - Research based-WWC
 - Asset Based Approach
- Intervention Groups- small groups based on needs
- Collaborate with teachers
 - Classroom instruction
 - IRIP
